- Led for 3 months until transferred.
- Started with me and one other person. Within 3 months was up to around 8 people total.

#### **Bible Study Leader, USCGC Decisive, Pascagoula, MS 2002**

- Started a Bible study on board USCGC Decisive. Led for 3 months until transferred.
- Started with me and one other, 5 guys regularly attending prior to departure for Advanced School.
- Great source of encouragement for all attending.

#### **Bible Study Leader, USCG Training Center Petaluma, Petaluma, CA 2002 - 2003**

- Started a Bible Study at Training Center Petaluma barracks.
- Started with one other, at the end, nearly 15 attending regularly.
- Led to a guy in my class (I was USCG class leader as well), who had persecuted me – getting saved and strong encouragement for all others.
- Completed Alpha Course out of Australia for first weeks.





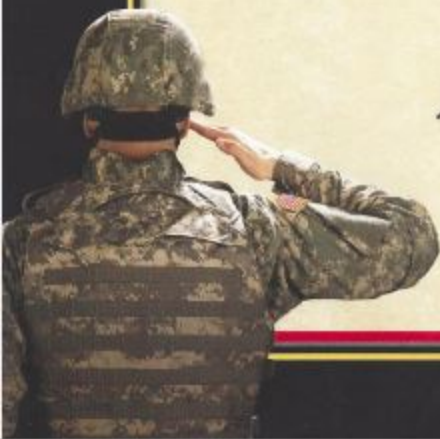
